From the off the Nottingham Cheetahs were in the top 5 teams, although the contest for first was hard fought, with the Nottingham Bears frequently in the lead. They were just pipped to the post by the Cheetahs in the last 10 minutes of the race, leaving the Bears second with only 1 less lap, while the Jaguars came in third with 165 laps.
